- ·Simple
 - · Clear
- ·Logical




Before giving clear instructions you should ask yourself a few important questions:

- · What kind of task are my ss going to do?(interview, gaps completing, questionary, mingling, etc)
 - · How should they do it? (individually, in groups/pairs)
- How can I help them to complete the task successfully?(ICQs, body language, demo technique)






Giving clearer instructions

Use a stronger learner to help

(...even at higher levels).



• To sound more naturally and friendly use Present Continuos rather than imperatives when asking ICQs «Are you making notes or labeling the pictures now»?

Try to avoid Yes/No questions and questions like `Clear`? `Understand`? because the students are usually programmed to respond immediately with a confirming answer, even if they do not understand. A student can have no clue what he or she is about to do, and if you ask "Okay?", the student will answer "Okay!" without even blinking.
